Advent Week of Prayer

Prayer Space at the Church Centre Chapel 8am-6pm each day

The chapel will be open for individual prayer, with four prayer stations and additional prayer resources for you to use if you wish. Or pray through the stations below wherever you find yourself this week.

First Prayer Station: Luke 2.6-20

The shepherds came with excitement to see the baby in the manger and left glorifying and praising God.

Is there anything that stops you feeling excited about coming to Jesus? Maybe you would like to talk to Him now about whatever the Holy Spirit brings to mind.

Third Station: Matthew 2.12

The Wise Men went back by another route. Is there anything that you would like to let go of or set down before the manger, or anyone that you might like to forgive, so that you can go back "by another route", knowing the Lord's healing and forgiveness?

Second Prayer Station: Matthew 2.1-11

The Wise Men came bringing gifts and bowed down in worship before Him.

Is there any gift that you would like to lay before the King of Kings in worship today?

- Making more room in our hearts is a gift;
- Choosing to spend more time with Him in prayer and in His word is a gift;
- Using the gifts and resources He has given us more prayerfully and intentionally is a gift

Which gift resonates with you?"

Fourth Station: Come, Lord Jesus!

Great is the darkness that covers the earth...but we can bring our own difficulties and those of others before the Lord in prayer. What is he calling you to pray for in this season of waiting?

Group Prayer at the Church Centre Chapel 8-9pm every evening

In addition to the Prayer Stations, there will be an hour of prayer from 8-9pm each evening, led by prayer or home group leaders. All are welcome to attend each or any session, but if you are unable to do so why not pray from wherever you are in the different ways outlined below.

Monday 3rd December

Oppression, injustice and pain – an opportunity to pray for the dark places in the world which God has laid on your heart. Please feel free to bring illustrative material to lay before the Lord as we pray together and ask 'Come, Lord Jesus...'

Tuesday 4th December

A time of quiet contemplation by candlelight drawing us closer to the Lord. Led by Antonia Cumming-Bruce and other members of Glynis Blake & Tim Abbot's home group.

A time of prayer and meditation focussing on each verse in turn of the hymn "Come, Lord Jesus". the world, the church and celebrating Jesus, finishing with a short time to share any words or pictures from the Lord.
