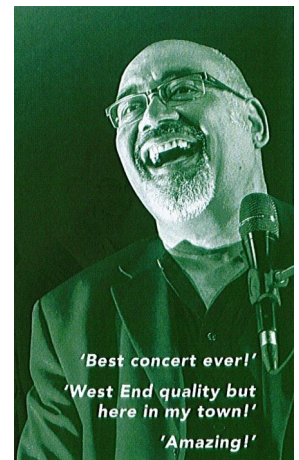
An unforgettable evening with the international singer and raconteur.

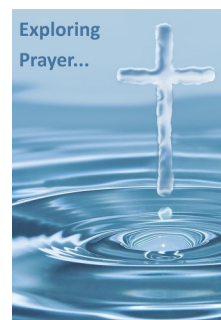
